2019 Craftinsure and E Howard-Davies GP14 Youth Training Week Information and Application Form

Sunday 28 July to Friday 2 August 2018 – Plas Menai, Caernarfon, Gwynedd.

The Craftinsure and E Howard-Davies GP14 Youth Training Week is an advanced race training course run over five days for helms and crews able to demonstrate racing competency and a desire to compete at GP14 championships. Sailors must also be under 22 on 31 Dec 2019, or still in full time education.

The cost of the week is £250. This cost principally covers your food and accommodation for the week, as the coaching is heavily subsidised by the E Howard-Davies Memorial Fund. Craftinsure are kindly providing sailors with team hoodies. We can take a maximum of eight boats, so have sixteen places available. We need a minimum of twelve sailors for the week to be viable.

The training week will be followed by the GP14 UK National Championships at Abersoch which is only 30 miles along the coast from Plas Menai.

The following guidelines will be used to select participants from the applications received:

- 1. Participation in recent GP14 events as helm or crew particularly championships and major events such as National or World Championships.
- 2. Participation in GP14 or club training events.
- 3. Ability to:
 - a. sail at a good club racing standard in a range of wind conditions, including planing conditions.
 - b. to right a capsized boat
 - c. to handle a GP14 ashore
- 4. A letter of support from your club Commodore, Training Principal or other recognised person who can confirm your ability and commitment to the GP14.
- 5. Access to a GP14 in good racing order.

Please use the form overleaf to apply for a place and send it to Julie in the GP14 Office. Applications should be received by Monday 18th March 2019 to be sure of consideration in the initial selection process. The final decision on who is invited to participate is at the absolute discretion of the Association.

Upon acceptance you will be required pay a deposit of £50. The balance of £200 and medical/consent forms will need to be received by Friday 31 May 2019. Sailors are required to be Youth members of the Association.

This event is being organised by the International GP14 Class Association for its youth members and is not designed to award any specific sailing or racing qualifications. The coaching will be provided on the Association's behalf by the National Outdoor Centre for Wales who will provide a Senior Instructor for the week. We will additionally use guest coaches with specific GP14 skills. Sailors will be housed on-site in our own annex. There will be a volunteer house parent system for the under 18s when they are not at the Centre.

Sailors will be expected to arrive on Sunday 22 July to rig their boats before the evening meal. Sailing will start on Monday morning. They should be ready to leave at 1700 on Friday 2 August.
