15	RISK STATEMENT
15.1	Rule 3 of the Racing Rules of Sailing states "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone".  Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:  (i) They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;  (ii) They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore;  (iii) They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions;  (iv) Their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to sail:  (v) The provision of a race management team, patrol boats and other officials and volunteers by the event organiser does not relieve them of their own responsibilities:  (vi)The provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances;  (vii) It is their responsibility to familiarise themselves with any risks specific to the venue or the event drawn to their attention in any rules and information produced for the event or venue and to attend any safety briefings for the event.  (viii) Their boat is adequately insured, with cover of at least £3,000,000 against third party claims.
	Note: each venue may display additional Risk Statements in the Supplementary Sailing Instructions.
16	INSURANCE
16.1	Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £3,000,000 per incident or the equivalent.
17	PRIZES
17.1	Prizes will be given as follows:  Trophies will be awarded to the winner of the Championship. Prizes will be awarded to the winners and other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the organisers.
